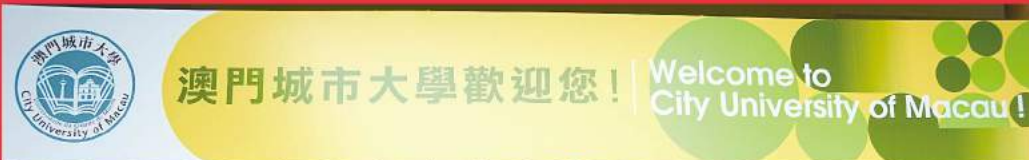

1.Enrollment Targets

- Macau Residents
- Foreigners who are living or working in Macau
- Student from Hong Kong, Taiwan and Overseas

2.Admission Criteria

- Bachelor' s Programmes:
Form 6 graduates or equivalent / age 25 or above
- Master' s Programmes:
Bachelor' s degree holders or equivalent
- Doctoral Degree Programmes:
Master' s degree holders or equivalent

3.Application Period

- From 2017/01/02 until further notice (Please check our University website or other media)

4.Application Procedure

- Applicants must log-on to the University online application system (<http://www.cityu.edu.mo>), to complete and submit the online application form according to the guidelines.
- Application fee for Macau residents: MOP200; Application fee for students from other regions: HKD200. All application fees paid are non-refundable.
- Applicants should upload their required supporting documents to the online application system. (Please make sure the information is accurate, and the certificate of the pre-qualification must be dated before 2017/09/01)

5.Admission Examinations

- Admission examinations are organized by the University and students will be admitted based on the examination scores.
- Please check our University website for the latest announcement of the Admission examination timetable.
- Written admission examination may be waived in the following circumstances, while interviews are still necessary:
(1)Students recommended by secondary school principals, universities and companies;
(2)Students with excellent pre-qualification.

6.Admissions

- The University will admit students according to the results of their admission interview and/or written examinations, and admission quotas of different faculties.
- The University will issue the admission notice to the candidates who are accepted; the admission results can also be checked via the University online application system.

7.Scholarship

In support of excellent students studying at the City University of Macau, various scholarships are offered to freshmen and incumbent students.

Other than the University scholarships, over twenty types of scholarship scheme are offered by different departments of the Macau SAR government, institutions, enterprises and community leaders.

Students with financial hardships are encouraged to apply for student grants set up the University (Temporarily for Macau students only)
